CuVerro is a class of touch surface material designed specifically for areas where cleanliness is a concern. It is the only solid touch surface material that is allowed to make public health claims in the US.

CuVerro copper alloys' inherent bactericidal properties are unsurpassed and represent the first (solid surface) class of EPA-registered materials that actively kill bacteria* continuously, 24 hours a day. It works by killing greater than 99.9% of bacteria, including MRSA, within 2 hours, helping to inhibit buildup and growth of bacteria* between routine cleaning and sanitizing steps.
